- A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 is required for admission. However, courses which have been completed with a grade of D are acceptable to meet program requirements unless the UW-Stout major requires a higher acceptable grade.
- The maximum number of transferable credits is 72.
- The attached program plan sheet reflects the requirements in the Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Management program that pertains to this agreement.
- In completing a degree in Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Management at UW-Stout, students transferring from Fox Valley Technical College will have to complete the following requirements:
