2. Elective courses taken at Gateway Technical College for the program will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they apply to the degree at UW-Stout.
3. Courses, which have been completed with a grade of D, are acceptable to meet program requirements unless the UW-Stout major requires a higher acceptable grade.
4. The maximum number of transferable credits is 72.
5. The attached program plan sheet reflects the requirements in the Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Management program that pertains to this agreement.
6. In completing a degree in Hotel, Restaurant and Tourism Management at UW-Stout, students transferring from Gateway Technical College will have to complete the following requirements:
