1. If courses have been substituted for those specified in the program at Northcentral Technical College, they would be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they apply to the degree at UW-Stout.
2. Elective courses taken at Northcentral Technical College for the program not listed in this agreement will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they apply to the degree at UW-Stout.
3. A cumulative grade point average of 2.5 is required for admission. However, courses which have been completed with a grade of D are acceptable to meet program requirements unless the UW-Stout major requires a higher acceptable grade.
4. A minimum of 32 credits must be earned at UW-Stout in order to be awarded a degree from UW-Stout.
5. The UW-Stout baccalaureate candidate must also meet UW-Stout's General Education, Ethnic Studies, and Global Perspective requirements in order to graduate from UW-Stout with a B.S. in Vocational Rehabilitation - Individualized Rehabilitation Concentration .
6. The attached program plan sheet reflects the requirements in the Vocational Rehabilitation - Individualized Rehabilitation Concentration program that pertains to this agreement.
7. In completing a degree in Vocational Rehabilitation - Individualized Rehabilitation Concentration at UW-Stout, students transferring from Northcentral Technical College will have to complete the following requirements:
