

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN-STOUT
AND
GATEWAY TECHNICAL COLLEGE**

This Agreement is entered into between **Gateway Technical College** (hereinafter Gateway Technical College), and the University of Wisconsin-Stout, Menomonie, WI (hereinafter receiving institution). This Agreement and any amendments and supplements, shall be interpreted pursuant to the guidelines set forth in the University of Wisconsin System Academic Information Series (ACIS) policy 6.2 Guidelines for Articulation Agreements between UW System Institutions and WTCS Districts as well as policy 6.0 Undergraduate Transfer Policy.

Gateway Technical College has established an **AAS Marketing – General Marketing** (hereinafter sending program), and the receiving institution has established a **B.S. Marketing & Business Education Online – Business Education License, Marketing Education License, Dual-License** (hereinafter receiving program), and will facilitate credit transfer and provide a smooth transition from one related program to another. It is mutually agreed:

I. Admission and Graduation Requirements

- A. The receiving institution's admission and program admission requirements apply to both direct entry students and to students who transfer under this agreement.
- B. Students must fulfill the graduation requirements at both institutions to include:
 - 1. General Education, Racial & Ethnic Studies and Global Perspective requirements;
 - 2. A minimum of 32 semester credits must be earned from UW-Stout to receive a degree from UW-Stout.
- C. Students must complete the entire sending program and meet the receiving institution's admission requirements for the agreement to apply.
- D. Education majors are admitted as Pre-Education. Acceptance into the UW-Stout professional program is based upon academic and non-academic criteria determined by the School of Education.
- E. A minimum of 2.75 cumulative GPA on transferable work is required for Education majors.
- F. Admission to UW-Stout does NOT guarantee admission to the professional program in the UW-Stout School of Education. To be admitted to the professional program, the student must have met the following Benchmark I Performance Based Assessment Requirements:
 - 1. Completed 40 semester credit hours
 - 2. 2.75 or greater cumulative GPA at UW-Stout
 - 3. Passed National background check – good for three (3) years

4. Passed Pre-Professional Skills Test OR CORE test (effective Fall 2014) OR have acceptable ACT, SAT or GRE scores that are no more than ten years old from the time the student enrolls in the program.
5. "C" or better in English and Speech requirements
6. Completed/currently enrolled in CTE 302 Principles of Career & Technical Education ("C" or better)
7. Satisfactory completion of Benchmark I:
 - i. Satisfactorily completed CTE 302 Principles of Career & Technical Education for portfolio*
 - ii. Satisfactorily completed resume for portfolio*
 - iii. Satisfactory rating on Disposition Assessment by Faculty*
 - iv. Satisfactorily completed artifacts and reflection evidences for electronic portfolio*
 - v. Satisfactory rating on Benchmark I

*To be completed in required course.

II. Transfer of Credits

- A. The receiving institution will apply 33-46 of the 70 credits from the sending program. A total of 71-91 credits remain to complete the receiving program.
- B. Courses will transfer as described in the attached Program Articulation Table.
- C. Courses are specifically identified in the attached Program Articulation Table requiring grades of "C" or higher that may be used towards the degree program. Grades received less than a "C" must be repeated if student is admitted into the program based on overall admission requirements.
- D. Elective courses taken or substituted at Gateway Technical College and sending program not listed in this agreement will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis and determined how they may apply to the degree at the receiving institution.

III. Implementation and Review

- A. The Provost, Dean, Program Director or designees of the parties to this agreement will implement the terms of this agreement, including identifying and incorporating any changes into subsequent agreements; assuring compliance with system policy, procedure and guidelines; and conducting a periodic review of this agreement.
- B. The University of Wisconsin-Stout and Gateway Technical College will provide academic advising to Gateway learners inquiring about UW-Stout's programs. Learners will be connected with a UW-Stout adviser prior to transfer. UW-Stout and Gateway will share materials, catalogs, and other information to facilitate their understanding of requirements and programs. Gateway will assist UW-Stout in arranging recruitment events on its campuses.
- C. Any marketing of this agreement will be subject to the prior approval of both parties and will adhere to each institution's standards for the use of its name and logo. Each institution will assume responsibility for appropriate marketing to reach its student population. Each institution may provide a link to this agreement and/or the other institution on its website, with notice to the other party.
- D. Both parties agree that failure to maintain regional accreditation will be grounds for termination of the agreement. Failure to maintain accreditation required by the

- specific academic program(s) referenced in this agreement will be grounds for exclusion of that program from the agreement.
- E. Gateway desires to track the articulation agreements by its students. If possible, receiving institution will send Gateway the total number of credits transferred from Gateway annually or other data that can be conveniently produced. This data need be requested by Gateway on an annual basis with ample lead time by UW-Stout to produce the data with a requested due date that the data is needed by Gateway.
 - F. This Articulation Agreement is effective on 11/11/2016 and shall remain in effect until the end date of 11/11/2021 or for five years, whichever occurs first, unless terminated or amended by either party with 180 days (six months) prior written notice. Gateway students who apply to UW-Stout prior to the cancellation date will be permitted to transfer credits under the agreement terms.
 - G. The college and university shall work with students to resolve the transfer of courses should changes to either program occur while the agreement is in effect.
 - H. This Articulation Agreement will be reviewed by both parties beginning 05/11/2021 (within six months of the end date).
 - I. When a student enrolls at the receiving institution following this agreement, the receiving institution will encode any course waivers and substitutions.
 - J. This articulation agreement applies only to the receiving program in effect fall 2016 until revised.
