

UW-Stout William J. (Bud) Micheels Undergraduate Scholarship

The UW-Stout Alumni Association awards one \$1,000 undergraduate scholarship annually, which is funded by the endowed portion of past alumni life memberships. Bud Micheels' vision for Stout was one "...where art and industry can thrive." This scholarship is being awarded to recognize Bud Micheels' vision based criteria listed below.

General Eligibility:

To be eligible, an applicant must:

1. Submit a completed application (typed) to the UW-Stout Alumni Office by the deadline date.
2. Must be an undergrad with at least 60 completed credits, and 10 credits in a minor, specialty or second major.
3. Have participated in university and community activities and groups.
4. Must submit two letters of recommendation:
 1. One letter should be from your work in your major or minor.
 2. The second letter should give evidence to your community activities and/or student involvement.
5. Must provide information on how they have helped others.
6. Provide a current transcript verifying two different areas of study.

Selection Process:

No one factor alone will be responsible for an applicant receiving a scholarship. Factors which are considered include: academic performance, teacher recommendations and comments, professional activities, community service (organized or individual) and written statements. The application must follow the format and is limited to the space provided. Any information in your application that cannot be used in future press releases or news articles should be clearly identified within the application.

Scholarship Deadline:

Applications, as well as the letters of recommendation, must be in the Alumni Association Office on or before **December 4, 2009, 4:00 pm** or they will not be considered. They can be mailed to: UW-Stout Alumni Association Office, P.O. Box 790, Menomonie, WI 54751-0790.

Notification Deadline: May 15

Final Report:

A written report must be sent to the UW-Stout Alumni Office at the end of the academic year.
