

# **UW-Stout Alumni Association Graduate Student Scholarship**

The UW-Stout Alumni Association awards two graduate scholarships annually, which are funded by the endowed portion of past alumni life memberships. Applicants must be enrolled in a UW-Stout graduate program or in the last semester of an undergraduate program and accepted and enrolled into graduate work at UW-Stout. The scholarship must be used for a graduate program at UW-Stout.

## **General Eligibility:**

To be eligible, an applicant must:

1. Have attained a degree from UW-Stout or be currently enrolled at UW-Stout in the last semester of an undergraduate or in a graduate program.
2. Have a minimum of four credits remaining to complete his/her degree.
3. Submit a completed typed application to the UW-Stout Alumni Office by the deadline date.
4. Limit answers to space provided.
5. Submit two letters of recommendation by application deadline.

## **Selection Process:**

No one factor alone will be responsible for an applicant receiving a scholarship. Factors which are considered include: academic performance, teacher and/or work-related recommendations and comments, professional activities, extracurricular activities and written statements. The application must be typed and is limited to the space on the attached pages. Any information in your application that cannot be used in future press releases or news articles should be clearly identified within the application.

## **Scholarship Deadline:**

Applications, as well as the letters of recommendation, must be in the Alumni Association Office on or before **December 4, 2009, 4:00 pm** or they will not be considered. They can be mailed to: UW-Stout Alumni Association Office, P.O. Box 790, Menomonie, WI 54751-0790.

## **Payments:**

Scholarship awards will be paid directly to Student Business Services to be applied to your tuition and fees. One half of the scholarship will be paid for the fall semester and the second half will be paid at the beginning of the second semester in January when we have verified that you are fully enrolled.

## **Final Report:**

A written report must be sent to the UW-Stout Alumni Office at the end of the academic year.
