Registration Fee

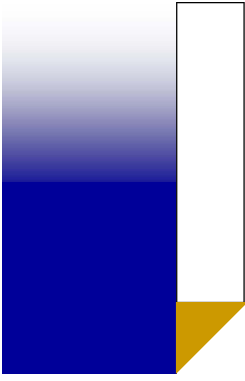
The registration fee is \$15.00 per student. It includes all sessions, materials and lunch. Adult chaperones must complete the registration form but are not required to pay the registration fee.
