





## How to Add a “Persistent” Link to a ProQuest Article in a Learn@UW Course

<p>1. Search and select a full text article to include in your Learn@UW course.</p> <p>At the top of the opened article, click on Copy Link.</p> <p>A pop up box with the durable link (or persistent link) appears.</p> <p>Highlight and copy the URL</p>	
<p>2. Now, in your Learn@UW course, on the nav bar, click Links .</p>	
<p>3. Still in the Learn@UW course, click New Link</p>	
<p>4. On the next screen, fill in the boxes.</p> <p>a. Select, or make, the category for the link.</p> <p>b. Enter the Article title.</p> <p>c. <b>The URL must include the library's ezproxy address to authenticate Stout students/faculty to be compliant with copyright of licensed databases!</b></p> <p>Type in the ezproxy address, then paste the URL of the article.</p> <p>d. Include a full citation in the description area.</p> <p>e. Click on Preview to check that the link works.</p> <p>f. Click on Save</p>	 <p><b>Be sure to type in the library's ezproxy address before pasting in the durable url for the article!
