Program Overview

This program is designed to support and strengthen minority students.

To ensure your preparation and transition to college, the Stoutward Bound Program enables a cohort of accepted incoming freshman (fall 2008) to participate in a summer bridge program allowing them to become oriented to college LIFE by:

- LEARN about the campus community
- IMPROVE strategies for academic success
- FOCUS on academic achievement
- EARN 5 college credits



Students benefit from participation in a learning community by:

- Developing friendships with likeminded students and faculty
- Out-of-the classroom activities that reinforce classroom learning
- Meaningful engagement to the campus and community

Plus...it's a great experience!!

Students will be enrolled in two courses that count in their fall registration:

- SPCOM100-038, Fundamentals of Speech (2credits)
- GEN ED Class, either a Humanities and the Arts (3 credits) or Social and Behavioral Science (3 credits) general course.

Tuition for SPCOM and Gen Ed. classes will be charged to your fall financial aid package.

Students will enter their fall term with a lightened course load which allows them to focus on academics.

Students will come to campus 2 weeks early (*August 17-30*), stay in university housing, eat in university facilities, and attend structured class formats Monday through Friday. There will also be activities for you to participate in. And of course, you'll have free time too.

Students will be prepared to transition to WEEK ONE orientation.
