A summer bridge program



Program Overview

Stoutward Bound is a summer bridge program open to incoming first-year students of color who are admitted to UW-Stout for the fall 2010 semester.

This summer bridge program is designed to give student college experience that will support and strengthen the college life that they will embark upon in the fall. For example, students will learn:

- The campus and community environment
- Strategies for achieving academic success
- Networking and relationship building
- They will also earn 5 college credits



This program will benefit students who participate in a variety of ways:

- They become part of a learning community
- They develop lifetime friendships with students and faculty
- They participate in outside classroom experiences and activities

This academic program is demanding and fun at the same time!

Students will be enrolled in two courses that will count towards their fall registration:

- SPCOM 100-017, Fundamentals of Speech (2 credits)
- PSYH 110, General Psychology (3 credits)

Tuition for these courses will be charged to the student's fall financial aid package.

Students will enter their fall term with a lightened course load, which allows them to focus on academics.

Students will arrive on campus Two (2) weeks early (August 22- September 3, 2010), live in university housing and eat in the university's dining facility. Students will attend structured classes Monday through Thursday; free time is built into the program and students can participate in fun activities.

Students Do Not pay for room and board during this time. Paid for by Plan 2008
