## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**How many credits do I need to graduate?**

This program requires 124 semester credits.

**How long does it take to complete the program?**

Most learners take four to six credits per semester while working full-time. If you take courses as part of the cohort sequence, you should finish in two years.

**How much does the program cost?**

\$265 per undergraduate credit through Summer 2009. Tuition rates are reviewed annually.
