

UW-Stout Announces An Opportunity to Add a Special Education Cross-Categorical Certification

UW-Stout post baccalaureate add-on Cross-Categorical licensure program is a specially designed cohort program for delivering services for students with disabilities in Cross-Categorical environments. The Cross-Categorical Special Education Licensure Program provides advanced study to licensed teachers and to teachers eligible for a Wisconsin teaching license. UW-Stout's program was developed according to the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction (DPI) Guidelines, the Wisconsin Ten Teaching Standards and the Council for Exceptional Children standards.

In Minnesota, the Program design has been approved for expansion of a current special education categorical license to include licenses in another categorical area.

The graduate level special education courses can be applied towards a master's degree in Education at the University of Wisconsin-Stout.
