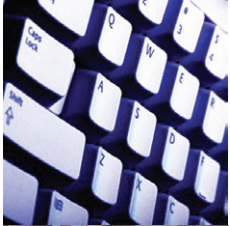




Vocational Rehabilitation Alternative Delivery



Designed for your convenience:

- ▶ Designed for busy working professionals in Northwestern Wisconsin.
- ▶ Degree requires 42 credits of general education, 5 elective credits, 55 rehabilitation credits, and a 22-credit concentration or minor.
- ▶ Any applicable transfer credits will apply toward the degree requirements.
- ▶ Participants will be limited in regard to concentration/minor options. Most alternative delivery participants will complete an individualized concentration.
- ▶ Individuals currently working in rehabilitation or a related field will be able to use their on-the-job experience for the experiential component of the degree.
- ▶ Applicants must be accepted to the University of Wisconsin-Stout.

Alternate delivery methods:

- ▶ Alternative delivery will include evening, weekend and/or online courses.
- ▶ All required rehabilitation course work will be offered via alternative delivery a minimum of once every two years.
- ▶ A minimum of two required rehabilitation courses will be offered via alternative delivery each term (*fall, spring*).
- ▶ General education course work available evenings, online or through UW-Extension Independent Learning.
