## FIVE QUALIFY TO GYMNASTICS NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

**MENOMONIE** (March 24, 2008) - Five UW-Stout gymnasts have qualified individually to the NCGA Championships, March 28-29, at SUNY-Cortland. All-Americans **Meaghan Hargens (So, Rosemount, Minn)** and **Ashley Timm (Sr, Eden Prairie, Minn)** return to the championships. Hargens and Timm are top two all-around qualifiers from the West Region. **Naomi DeLara (Fr, Kahului, Hawai'i)** is top seeded in the balance beam. **Morgan Trumble (So, Woodbury, Minn)** qualified on the beam and **Rachel Manz (So, St. Paul, Minn)** qualified on the uneven bars. Timm is making her fourth consecutive trip to the national meet. Hargens is making her second, while DeLara, Trumble and Manz are making their first trip.

## JULIA HIRSSIG NAMED TO D3HOOPS.COM TEAM

**MENOMONIE** (March 18, 2008) - UW-Stout's **Julia Hirssig (So, Rochester, Minn/Mayo)** was named to the D3hoops.com All-Central Region second team. Hirssig finished the season leading the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (WIAC) with 16.1 points and 9.1 rebounds per game. Her school record field goal percentage of .648 (175-270) topped the WIAC. Hirssig rejected 21 shots on the year, putting her third in the conference. She collected a conference-high 12 double-doubles on the season, and was one of two players to score 30 points in a game. Hirssig scored at least 20 points six times, all of which came in the team's final 10 games.

## JACK WOLGEMUTH SECOND TEAM ALL-AMERICAN

**MENOMONIE** (March 22, 2008) - UW-Stout defenseman **Jack Wolgemuth (Jr, Anchorage, Alaska)** was named to the second team of the RBK Hockey Division III Men's All-American ice hockey team. Wolgemuth scored seven goals and 23 assists for 30 points. The 6-foot, 3-inch defenseman had five power play goals for Stout (18-9-3), which qualified to the NCAA playoffs this year for the first time. Wolgemuth was a first team all-conference selection in the WIAC and the NCHA.

## SOFTBALL TRIP TO HAWAII ENDS IN LOSSES TO CHAMINADE

**WAIPULA, Hawaii** (March 18, 2008) - UW-Stout jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the second game, but couldn't hold it and fell to Chaminade University, 8-3, in the Blue Devils' final game of their spring break trip to Hawaii. In the first game, Chaminade took a 2-0 lead, then held on for a 3-1 win. Leadoff hitter **Savanah Oeltjen (Sr, Spring Valley, Minn)** reached in the first game with a shallow double that fell between two Silversword players. **Nelly Peterson (Jr, Cumberland)** drove Oeltjen home with a two-out single to left field. **Katie Fichter (Jr, Baraboo)** plated Peterson with a single two batters later. Chaminade answered back with two runs in the second to knot the game, then took the lead with a run in the second and got the eventual game-winning run in the third. **Kelly Conway (Fr, La Crescent, Minn)** drove in **Beth Lloyd (Sr, Fond du Lac)** for Stout's final run of the game in the fifth inning. Chaminade (8-15), an NCAA Division II program, added two runs in both the fifth and the sixth.

In the opener, Chaminade took a 1-0 lead in the second, then added two runs in the third. The Blue Devils (7-9) got their only run of the game when **Chelsey Nelson (Fr, Rochester, Minn)** scored on a suicide squeeze bunt by Peterson. The Blue Devils stranded runners in each of the last five innings. **Kaitlin Helgaas (Fr, Fond du Lac)** led Stout, going 2-for-2 with two bunt singles and reached all three times to the plate.

Stout is scheduled, weather permitting, to open conference play, Tuesday, April 1 at UW-Eau Claire.

## BLUE DEVILS EDGED BY CHAMINADE IN NIGHTCAP

**WAIPULA, Hawaii** (March 18, 2008) - After a far less than ideal opening game loss, the UW-Stout softball team recovered for a very respectable showing in a 3-2 loss to NCAA Division II Chaminade University, Tuesday at Oahu Regional Park. Chaminade (6-15) jumped all over the Blue Devils (7-7) in a 16-0, five inning affair in the opener. But the Blue Devils bounced back to take a 2-0, first inning lead in the second game. **Chelsey Nelson (Fr, Rochester, Minn)** reached on a one-out single to right field. She advanced to second on a sacrifice bunt by **Nelly Peterson (Jr, Cumberland)**, then came home on a double by **Beth Lloyd (Sr, Fond du Lac)**. **Taylor Wild (Fr, Apple Valley, Minn)** plated Lloyd with a single to right field. Wild would go 2-for-3 in the game. The Silver Swords cut the lead in half with a single run in the bottom of the second. Chaminade's Emily Harris would pick up the eventual game winning RBIs, smashing a two-run double in the fourth inning.

## BLUE DEVILS DROP TWO GAMES TO BYU-HAWAII

**HA'ULA, Hawaii** (March 17, 2008) - **Savanah Oeltjen (Sr, Spring Valley, Minn)** and **Beth Lloyd (Sr, Fond du Lac)** both went 4-for-4 in the opener and UW-Stout took their first lead of their Hawaiian trip in the second game, but the Blue Devils dropped both games to BYU-Hawaii, Monday. BYU took the first contest 7-2 and the second, 9-1, in six innings. The Seasideers (6-18) jumped out to a 4-0 run before Stout scored a single run in the third inning when Lloyd plated Oeltjen with a single to right field. Stout added another lead, and again it was Lloyd driving in Oeltjen, this time with a double to centerfield. BYU added a run in the fifth and two in the sixth.

In the opener, Stout (7-5) took the lead when Oeltjen hit a triple to right field, then came home on an errant throw in the top of the first. The Seasideers tied the score when Melissa Lehano hit a solo home run. BYU tacked on two runs in the second, one in the fourth, three in the fifth and ended the game with two runs in the sixth. Oeltjen was 6-for-7 on the day and reached safely the first six times she came to the plate. Oeltjen had three singles and a triple in the first game. Lloyd had the teams only two RBIs of the day, both coming in the first game. Stout did not help their own cause in the second game, by committing seven errors.

## BLUE DEVILS FALL TO UNDEFEATED HAWAII PACIFIC

**KANEOHE, Hawaii** (March 16, 2008) - The UW-Stout softball team lost to undefeated Hawaii Pacific University, 8-0, 10-0, Sunday. The Sea Warriors' (17-0) Courtney Kessell threw a perfect game in the opener, facing only the minimum 15 batters in the contest. Stout (7-3) did not allow the same to happen in the second game as **Savanah Oeltjen (Sr, Spring Valley, Minn)** opened the contest with a lead-off, single and **Megan McDonald (So, Hudson)** followed that with an infield single, but three straight outs finished the inning. Hawaii Pacific got a single run in the third, then exploded for nine runs in the fourth, sending 13 to the plate.

## BLUE DEVIL BASEBALL CONCLUDES SOUTHWEST TRIP WITH LOSS

**PHOENIX, Ariz.** (March 20, 2008) - UW-Stout (6-5) concluded their spring break trip to Arizona with a 6-1 loss to Concordia-Wisconsin, Thursday. The Falcons jumped the Blue Devils for two runs in the bottom of the first inning, then added single runs in the second and third innings. The Blue Devils got on the board when **Tim Schneider (Sr, West Salem)** led off the fifth inning with a home run, but that would be it for Stout. Concordia added another solo run in the seventh inning.

Stout is scheduled to open the conference schedule, March 29-30, at UW-Platteville, weather and field conditions permitting.

## HAMLIN SWEEPS BLUE DEVILS

**PHOENIX, Ariz.** (March 19, 2008) - UW-Stout was swept by Hamline, 11-3, 4-3, Wednesday, the first time the Blue Devils have been swept all season. In the opener, the Pipers jumped out to a 10-0 lead until Stout scored two runs in the bottom of the sixth. Stout added another run in the seventh inning. Hamline outhit Stout, 11-7. **Greg Smolinski (So, Menasha)** was 2-for-3 with an RBI.

In the second game, Stout (6-4) took a 2-0 lead in the third inning on RBIs by **Mike White (Sr, Rochester, Minn)** and **Eric Paul (Sr, Wisconsin Rapids)**. Hamline (8-6) answered back with four runs in the bottom of the inning, all they would really need. Stout tightened the score when **Andy Lorenzen (Jr, Menomonie)** drove in **Alex Burian (Fr, Eau Claire)** in the fifth. White extended his hitting streak to 23 games, getting two hits in the first game and a single hit in the second game.

## BLUE DEVIL BASEBALL POUNDS ST. JOHN'S

**PHOENIX, Ariz.** (March 18, 2008) - UW-Stout collected 17 hits and all nine starters had at least one hit as the Blue Devils pounded St. John's University, 15-5, Tuesday. **Erik Johnson (Sr, LaCrosse)**, **Greg Smolinski (So, Menasha)** and **Brian Giebel (So, River Falls)** each had two RBI in leading Stout's offensive attack. Giebel had two doubles, Johnson a double and Smolinski a two run home run. **Josh Brandt (Jr, Wausau)** went eight innings to pick up his first collegiate win, striking out five as he scattered six hits and allowed two earned runs. St. John's took an early 1-0 lead in the second inning, but Stout (6-2) came back with a four-run second. The Blue Devils put the game on ice with a seven run eighth.

## STOUT SPLITS GAMES WITH AUGBURG

**PHOENIX, Ariz.** (March 17, 2008) - **Erik Johnson (Sr, La Crosse)** collected five RBIs and went 4-for-4 as UW-Stout earned a split with Augsburg College, Monday, losing the first, 6-2, but coming back to win the second, 8-4. Johnson clubbed out a two-run home run in the second game and also collected a double in Stout's win. **Eric Paul (Sr, Wisconsin Rapids)** was 3-for-4 with an RBI off a double. **Bryan Vilstrup (Sr, Frederic)** picked up the win with five strikeouts. **Bryan Chelekian (Fr, Prospect Heights, Ill)** earned his first collegiate save. Blue Devil hitters whacked out 14 hits with the first five hitters in the order bagging a collective 11 hits.

In the series opening loss, three Stout errors led to four unearned runs by Augsburg and the Blue Devils could never recover.

## BLUE DEVILS WHACK MACALESTER

**PHOENIX, Ariz.** (March 16, 2008) - **Erik Johnson (Sr, La Crosse)** went 2-for-4 with four RBIs, including a two-run home run to lead UW-Stout to a 16-3 win over Macalester College Sunday. Johnson got the Blue Devils (4-1) going with a two run blast to deep left centerfield to give Stout a 3-2 lead. Stout proceeded to score 13 unanswered runs until Macalester scored a single run in the ninth inning. Stout tallied two runs in the fourth, four in the fifth, four in the seventh and three in the eighth on a 15-hit attack. **Matt Krause (Sr, Bonduel)** was 3-for-5 with two RBI as six Stout hitters had at least two hits. **Matt Doornink (Jr, Cottage Grove, Minn)** took the win by striking out 11 and allowing two earned runs on three hits. With the win, Blue Devil coach Craig Walter won his 100th game at Stout. Walter is currently in his seventh year at Stout. He holds a 100-138 record with the Blue Devils and has coached at UW-Eau Claire and UW-River Falls, tallying a 243-162 overall record.

## ST. THOMAS DOWNS STOUT IN NCAA HOCKEY PLAYOFFS

**MENDOTA HEIGHTS, Minn** (March 12, 2008) - St. Thomas scored two goals within a 10 second period midway through the third period and bounced UW-Stout, 4-1, from the NCAA Division III tournament. With the score tied at 1-1 after two periods, the Tommies (20-6-2) attacked Blue Devil goalie **Mike Stone (Sr, West St. Paul, Minn)** hard. St. Thomas outshot Stout 12-4 over the first 10 minutes of the final stanza and landed a power play goal at the 10 minute mark by Nate Ryan. Ten second later, at 10:10, the Tommies took a two goal lead on a goal by Sean Bryant. The Tommies sealed the deal with an empty net goal by Nick Nelson with just less than a minute left. The game was tied after the first period. The Blue Devils opened the scoring when **Derek Hanson (So, Bemidji, Minn)** scored at the 7:08 mark, with assists by **Joel Gaulrapp (So, Owatonna, Minn)** and **Scott Motz (So, Lake Elmo, Minn)**. The Tommies knotted the score around the 16 minute mark on a goal by Rob Johnson.

The Blue Devils outshot St. Thomas 14-7 in the second period, but couldn't crack one past goalie Tyler Chestnut. St. Thomas outshot Stout, 35-28 on the evening. Stout held a 23-17 lead in shots after two periods. St. Thomas will travel to St. Norbert to play the top seeded Green Knights, Saturday, March 15.
