TITANS USE BIG PLAYS TO DOWN BLUE DEVILS

OSHKOSH (October 6, 2007) - Big plays were the name of the game and, unfortunately for UW-Stout, UW-Oshkosh seemed to get the all of the big plays as the Titans defeated Stout, 23-13, Saturday at JJ Keller Field. Oshkosh got two big plays that turned into scores, but the Titans had more big plays that set up touchdowns as they jumped out to a 23-0 lead a few minutes into the third period. Conference leading rusher Andy Moriarty hooked up with quarterback Joe Patek for a 53 yard pass reception to put Oshkosh up 7-0. Lucas Raschke connected on a 50 yard field goal with three minutes left in the first quarter, but a 48-yard pass from Patek to Steve Stoltz helped to set up the score. The Titans (4-1, 1-1) took a 16-0 lead when Tyler Jandrin took a Patek pass 69 yards to the Stout one yard line. Jandrin carried on the next two possessions to score. On the Titans' first play from scrimmage in the second half, Patek found Andy Heiman for an 80 yard touchdown score and Stout trailed 23-0. Blue Devil quarterback **Tanner Kattre (Sr, Abbotsford)** put the offense on his back a couple of drives later. The Blue Devils got on the scoreboard with 4-minutes, 56-seconds left in the third quarter when Kattre went over from the eight. On the 13-play, 80-yard scoring drive, Kattre ran for 53 yards, and passed for 23. Stout (2-3, 1-1) got on the board early in the fourth quarter when Kattre carried over from the one yard line to complete the 10-play, 46-yard drive. Kattre also had a 14 yard rush in the drive and completed a 15-yard pass to **Shawn Korth (Sr, Marshall)** for a first down to the Oshkosh 5.

"They had the big plays and we didn't," coach Duey Naatz told WMEQ radio after the game. "That's why they won. We had a our chances and we will be sick to our stomachs (while watching the game tape) when we see the opportunities that we had, but didn't get."

"When you are on the road in this league, and you don't make the big play, you don't win."

The Blue Devils held a slight lead in total yardage, picking up 408 yards to 383 yards for the Titans. Stout collected 237 yards rushing to 56 for Oshkosh, but the Titans controlled the battle in the air, hauling 327 yards to 171 for Stout. Patek completed 13-of-24 passes for all 327 yards and two touchdowns, completing passes to six players. Heiman had two catches for 93 yards, Jandrin two for 80 yards, Stoltz two for 68 and Moriarty two for 67 yards. Moriarty, who was averaging 162 yards rushing per game, was limited to 72 yards. Kattre led all rushers with 145 yards on 27 carries and was 13-of-30 in passing for 140 yards, but was picked off three times. **Andy Reese (Sr, Lodi)** ran 19 times for 75 yards. **Dan Lytle (Jr, Darien)** had five catches for 63 yards and f.html#white_calvin" **Calvin White (Fr, Benton Harbor, Mich)** had five grabs for 47 yards. **Kyle Provos (So, Brooklyn Park, Minn)** completed three passes for 31 yards, but was intercepted once. The Titans collected four interceptions with Bryan Kent taking two picks. Eric Hebl and Josh Wara each had an interception. Both teams had a little trouble hanging onto the ball, with Stout fumbling twice and Oshkosh three times, but neither team lost a fumble.

The game is the FSN Wisconsin game of the week and will be rebroadcast, Tuesday, Oct. 9 at 7 p.m.

PIONEERS TAKE BLUE DEVILS IN THREE GAMES

PLATTEVILLE (October 6, 2007) - UW-Platteville kept UW-Stout winless in WIAC play by taking a 3-0 win over the Blue Devils Saturday. The Pioneers, hitting at a .351 clip, took a 30-20, 30-18, 30-17, win. Platteville (18-7, 2-3) were led by Rachel Chapman with 13 kills and Lisa Bell with 12 kills. Stout (9-12, 0-5) got nine kills apiece from **Linda Meyer (Sr, Cedarburg)** and **Maggie Meixl (Jr, Mankato, Minn)**. Stout hit .118 on the afternoon. After a five match winning streak in September, Stout has now dropped nine of their last 10 matches. The Blue Devils will be at UW-River Falls, Wednesday, Oct. 10.

LA CROSSE GIVES STOUT THREE-GAME LOSS

LA CROSSE (October 5, 2007) - UW-Stout put up a fight in the third game, but it proved to be too late as the Blue Devils lost to 20th ranked UW-La Crosse, 30-14, 30-15, 30-28, Friday at Mitchell Hall. La Crosse (17-4, 2-2) had three players in double digits in kills, while Stout (9-11, 0-4) got a match-high nine kills from **Maggie Meixl (Jr, Mankato, Minn)**. Katelyn Carlson had 14 kills to lead La Crosse, while Nina Walch had 13 and Amber Schoonover finished with 10. La Crosse finished the match hitting .330, while Stout was held to .130.

STOUT LOSES A NAIL-BITER TO EAU CLAIRE

MENOMONIE (October 3, 2007) - UW-Stout won a fourth game to tie up the match, but lost a heartbreaking fifth game, as they fell to UW-Eau Claire, 22-30, 30-14, 30-26, 25-30, 15-0, Wednesday, in the Johnson Fieldhouse. **Jenna Swanson (So, Hayfield, Minn)** led the Blue Devils with 15 kills, followed by **Linda Meyer (Sr, Cedarburg)**, who had 11. **Jenna Welsh (Sr, Abbotsford)** had a game-high 40 assists, as well as 3 service aces. Four Blue Devils went into double digits in digs, including **Alicia Mizer (So, Barron)**, who was credited with 22 and **Casey Huntoon (Sr, Mantorville, Minn)** with 20. For the Blugolds, Abby Freiborg led the way with with a match-high 20 kills. Lissa Martinez and Nikki Peterson each had 10. Freiborg also led Eau Claire in digs with 21, followed closely by Heather Harnell, who dug up 18. In the fourth game, Swanson put down five kills to lead the way. In the fifth and deciding contest, Meyer had three kills and Swanson and Pagel each added two kills, but it was errors that turned the tide. Leading 5-2, Stout had five errors over the next nine points to fall behind, 10-6. The Blugolds' Freiborg collected four kills in the final nine points of the match. BLUE DEVILS HAND EAGLES FIRST LOSS OF SEASON

MENOMONIE (October 4, 2007) - UW-Stout's match against UW-La Crosse came down to the final match of the night: the No. 6 singles match. Stout's **Sarah Smith (Fr, Stevens Point)** delivered the victory, giving the Blue Devils a 5-4 win over the Eagles, Thursday at the south courts. Stout (5-3, 2-3) got off to an early lead after the doubles matches. At number one doubles, the duo of **Allie Hinman (Fr, Lino Lakes, Minn)** and **Natalie Hahn (Sr, Mound, Minn)** pounded their opposition, 8-1. In the number two spot, **Kiersten Johnson (So, Andover, Minn)** and **Michelle Hohl (Sr, Portage)** defeated their opponents, 8-4, giving Stout an early 2-0 lead. **Jodie Czech (Jr, Foley, Minn)** and **Lindsey Lubberda (So, Champlin, Minn)** nearly completed the perfect 3-0 doubles for Stout, but lost in a heart-breaking tie-breaker, 9-8 (7-5). In singles play, both Hinman and Hohl won their matches, becoming Stout's only double winners of the day. Johnson lost her singles match in two sets. Czech and Hahn each lost theirs in three. That set the stage for the last match of the day. With the teams in a 4-4 tie, and only one match left, it meant Stout's fate lay in the hands of No. 6 singles, Sarah Smith. Smith won her first set in a 7-3 tie-breaker. She then performed well under pressure in the second set, defeating the Eagles' Kristen Holle, 6-4, giving Stout the win. La Crosse dropped to 4-1, 2-1 in the WIAC.

MOLLY LONEY FINISHES SIXTH AT WIAC TOURNEY

WATERTOWN (October 7, 2007) - UW-Stout's **Molly Loney (Jr, River Falls)** hit the third best score of the day and finished sixth at the WIAC Women's Golf Championships at Windwood in Watertown Sunday.

Loney, coming into Sunday's final day of competition in a tie for 12th place after carding an 87, turned in an 80, trailing only the top two finishers in the meet, UW-Eau Claire's Meghan Sobotta and UW-Stevens Point's Jessica Urban. Urban turned in a 78 Sunday and finished second overall (82-78 - 160), while Sobotta carded a 79 and won medalist honors (80-79 - 159). The sixth place finish gives Loney (87-80 - 167) first team all conference honors and vastly improves on her 2006 finish of 21st place.

All five of Stout's performers either improved scores from the first day or matched them as Stout finished seventh overall. This was the second year the meet was held at Windwood and Stout dropped 28 strokes from their score from last year's championship.

Morgan Loney (Fr, River Falls) finished 16th (87-86 - 173), **Cynthia Huber (Fr, White Bear Lake, Minn)** finished in a tie for 33rd (96-94 - 190), **Kelsey Treptow (So, Wells, Minn)** was 38th (98-98 - 196) and onnell_cadi" **Cadi O'Connell (So, New Richmond)** was 39th (103-97 - 200).

UW-Stevens Point won the team title, placing three golfers in the top five, and displacing three-time champion UW-Eau Claire, which slipped to fourth. The Pointers won an automatic bid to the NCAA Division III Championships next May.

The meet concludes the fall season. Stout will resume play again in April, 2008.

BLUE DEVIL MEN IN FOURTH AFTER FIRST DAY AT VITERBO

LA CROSSE (October 7, 2007) - UW-Stout's **Matt Fiedler (Fr, Plymouth, Minn)** was in a tie for sixth place after the first day of the Ronnie Eastman Invitational sponsored by Viterbo University at the La Crosse Country Club Sunday.
