POINTERS EKE OUT ANOTHER OVER BLUE DEVILS

STEVENS POINT (October 13, 2007) - UW-Stevens Point ran their conference winning streak to seven games by edging UW-Stout, 26-23, Saturday at Goerke Field. The Pointers have won all seven of those games by three points or less and the Blue Devils were on the receiving end of one of those close games last season, losing 20-19 in Menomonie.

Stout's **Stephen Schills (Sr, Green Bay)** got his first of two interceptions of the day on Stevens Point's first drive. That interception, returned to Stevens Point's four yard line, gave the Blue Devils prime field position. On the first play of the ensuing drive, **Tanner Kattre (Sr, Abbotsford)** hooked up with **Patrick Mengelkoch (Fr, Brooklyn Park, Minn)** for a four-yard touchdown, giving Stout the early 7-0 lead. In the second quarter, Stout (2-4, 1-2) was threatening to increase their lead as they drove deep into Stevens Point territory. That drive, however, came to a screeching halt when a **Kyle Provos (So, Brooklyn Park)** pass was intercepted by Luke Frisch at the 10 yard line. Later in the quarter, Stevens Point (6-0, 3-0) was able to put up six points of their own on two of Ryan Graboski's four field goals on the day, to close to within 7-6 at halftime.

On their first possession of the second half, Pointers quarterback Jake Swank completed five out of six pass attempts, leading his team to a third Graboski's field goal, and their first lead of the game, 9-7, at 10:58 in the third quarter. On the next Stout possession, a **Kyle Martin (So, Hubertus)** 42-yard punt out of bounds at the Stevens Point three yard line put the Pointers' backs against the wall. On Stevens Point's first play of that drive, **Kyle Seiler (Jr, Rockford, Minn)** sacked Swank in the end zone for a safety, tying the game up at nine apiece. Stout took advantage of the safety by marching 64 yards down the field - 29 yards came on a reception by **Dan Lytle (Jr, Darien)** from Provos and 15 on a Pointer pass interference - on the ensuing possession, setting up a one-yard touchdown run by **Andy Reese (Sr, Lodi)**, putting Stout up a touchdown. The Pointers matched that touchdown when Swank hit a wide open David Hammer for 17 yards and the score. A successful extra point tied the game up at 16. After a Stout three and out, Stevens Point quickly drove down the field again, going 82 yards in just over three minutes, scoring on a Mike Ferron 10-yard touchdown scamper.

Stout was not ready to give up yet. On their next possession, quarterback Kyle Provos took advantage of a blown coverage and hooked up with **Eric Cieslak (Fr, Rochester, Minn)** for the game-tying score with 2:11 left in the game. On the ensuing kickoff, Kasey Morgan broke free, returning the ball to the Stout 28 yard line, putting his team in field goal range with under a minute to play. Needing not much more than a few short runs to win the game, Stevens Point nearly turned the ball over twice. One interception was called back due to defensive pass interference, and the other was ruled caught out of bounds by the Stout defender. In the end, however, Graboski kicked his school record tying fourth field goal of the game, leaving just 16 seconds for Stout to score.

Stevens Point gathered 387 total yards of offense, 221 through the air, 166 on the ground. Swank completed 21-of-41 passes for all of the yardage, a touchdown pass and was picked off twice by Stout's Schills. Brad Kalsow hauled in seven catches for 102 yards. Mike Ferron was the Pointers' leading rusher with 72 yards on 32 carries. Provos completed 6-of-11 passes for 129 yards and the TD to Cieslak. Kattre completed was 4-for-10 for 25 yards, with the TD pass to Mengelkoch. Kattre was held to 23 yards rushing, had two receptions for 20 yards and averaged 34.5 yards on two punts. Reese led all rushers with 74 yards on 24 carries and caught four passes for 34 yards. Seiler finished with 11 tackles, eight solo Dustin Robinson had 12 tackles, nine solo, to lead Stevens Point.

VOLLEYBALL TEAM PUTS END TO SKID, DOWN FALCONS

RIVER FALLS (October 10, 2007) - **Jenna Swanson (So, Hayfield, Minn)** continued to make her presence known as she helped UW-Stout snap a seven match losing streak as the Blue Devils defeated UW-River Falls, 3-1, Wednesday. Swanson recorded a career-high 20 kills in leading Stout to a 30-25, 30-19, 24-30, 30-27 win over the Falcons. The win also gave Stout (10-12, 1-5) their first WIAC win of the season. Swanson was joined in the double-digit kills column by teammates **Linda Meyer (Sr, Cedarburg)** with 13 kills and **Maggie Meixl (Jr, Mankato, Minn)** with 12 kills. Meixl was also tough on the net, recording three solo blocks and four block assists. The Falcons (5-18, 1-5) were led by Kelsey Scheele's 12 kills.

Stout will be off until Tuesday, Oct. 16 when they are at St. Scholastica, then host UW-Whitewater, Friday, Oct. 19 and UW-Oshkosh, Saturday, Oct. 20.

PHYSICAL GAME FINDS SOCCER TEAM ON SHORT END

MENOMONIE (October 13, 2007) - In a game that saw 15 fouls on both teams and pushing and checking were the norm, UW-Stout came up short, 2-1, to UW-Whitewater, Saturday at Nelson Field. The Warhawks (9-6-1, 3-2-1) opened the scoring in the 24th minute when Alyssa Palmer scored, but Stout (4-10-0, 2-4-0) came right back four minutes later when **Rachel Herzog (Jr, Owatonna, Minn)** scored her first collegiate goal on an assist by **Katie Ness (Fr, River Falls)**. Whitewater got the eventual winner in the 34th minute on a goal by Allison Davis and it was defense from there-on out. The teams were limited to only 15 total shots - eight for Whitewater, seven for Stout - and Whitewater had six shots on goal, while Stout put five on goal. Both Stout's goalkeeper, **Jessica Halvorson (Jr, Delano, Minn)** and Whitewater's keeper, Amy Bailey, had four saves.
